

Brief CV of Professor Don McQuillan

Don McQuillan was born in Dundalk, Ireland. He is married with four children.

He holds first class honours B.Sc. and M.Sc degrees in Mathematical Science, National University of Ireland, and a PhD in Mathematics, Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, USA.

He has been full professor of Mathematics in University of Wisconsin, Madison, and University College Dublin, where he was also Head of Department and Dean of the Faculty.

He has given invited lectures on his research in universities in France, Germany, Ireland, UK and USA. He has published widely in international mathematics journals, including the “American Journal of Mathematics” and “Journal für die reine und angewandte Mathematik”.

He has held visiting positions in
University of Cambridge, England (NSF-funded visiting mathematician),
Université de Bordeaux and Université de Caen, France (Professeur Associé),
University of Iowa, USA (Visiting Professor).

From 2002 to 2005 he was Chief Executive of the Irish Universities Quality Board, and Assistant Director (Academic) of the Irish Universities Association.

He has been an invited keynote speaker at international conferences on QA held in Slovakia, Czech Republic, Sweden, Greece, England, Thailand. He is a member of the Expert Pool of the European Universities Association International Evaluation Programme, is advisor/consultant to the Holy See Quality Assurance Agency AVEPRO (Agenzia per la Valutazione e la Promozione della Qualità delle Facoltà Ecclesiastiche) and to ACUQA (the African Catholic Universities Quality Agency). He is a member of AVEPRO's Scientific Council.
